
Some books are available in both easy-to-read Swedish and another language, for example Swedish and Arabic or Swedish and Dari. Many books are also available as audiobooks.

Easy-to-read news

8 Sidor (8 Pages) is a newspaper in easy-to-read Swedish. The 8 Sidor newspaper does not belong to a political party or an association. The journalists at the newspaper decide which news is important to report on. You can read 8 Sidor at the library. You can also read and listen to 8 Sidor on the internet or using an app on your mobile phone.

Radio Sweden på lätt svenska is a news programme for people who have recently arrived in Sweden. A new programme with the most important news stories is made available every day, Monday to Friday, at four in the afternoon. You can listen to the programme directly on its website or download it to your computer or your mobile phone.

Easy-to-read community information

Many government authorities have information in easy-to-read Swedish. Look for the symbol LL or the word Lättläst (which means easy to read) on the websites. Most government authorities also have information in other languages. Look for the text Other languages. Here are examples of government authorities that have information in several languages: **migrationsverket.se arbetsformedlingen.se forsakringskassan.se**

Information om Sverige (Information about Sweden) is a website for people who have recently arrived in Sweden. The website has information about Sweden and Swedish society in easy-to-read Swedish and in other languages. **informationsverige.se**
